ORDER

Under JNNURM Government of India have approved projects in the following schemes.

- 1) Urban Infrastructure
- 2) Basic Services for the Urban Poor
- 3) UIDSSMT
- 4) IHSDP

The Pattern of assistance under all the schemes for all Cities and Towns except Kochi is 80 % by Government of India and 10% by the State Government the remaining 10% has to be contributed by the Local Governments concerned. In the case of Kochi, 50% would be Government of India's share 20% State share and 30% Local Government Share. Government of India has released Central Grants to different Municipalities and Corporations.

Government are pleased to allow Municipalities and Corporations receiving Central assistance for the year 2006-07 to remit their share proportionate to the Central releases utilizing their Development Funds of the current year (2006-07). This amount should be deposited in a Treasury Savings Bank. Account to be opened for the purpose.

The Proportionate State shares of Urban Infrastructure and UIDSSMT would be transferred to KSUDP and of BSUP and IHSDP would be transferred to Kudumbashree. KSUDP and Kudumbashree are permitted to open TSB Accounts for this purpose.
