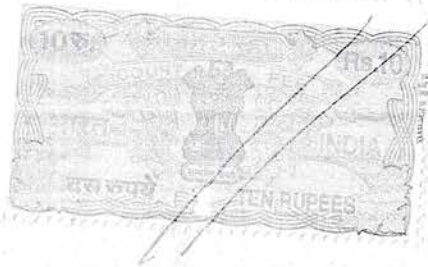

Ref: -

A multistoried building is having two Basements (Basement – I, Basement –II)

Below the Ground floor. In the Ground floor there is road of not less than 5 m width at 3 sides and not less than 4 m at one side, below which 2 Basements are there. The road abuts to the Municipal road at eastern side at a distance of not less than 25 m and runs to northern, western and southern sides and meets at the eastern side set back over the Basement at eastern side.

The Basement portion is fully car park and there is separate entrance for each Basement. At the North, West and South sides the road width is not less than 5 m. The dwelling units starts from the 1st floor only.
